### Reading:

We read The Amazing Little Porridge Pot and Strega Nona. We made a venn diagram to compare and contrast the two stories. We read Tortillas and Lullabies. With this story we discussed some of our family traditions. We have been working in smaller groups on reading stories for more one on one time. This helps with grouping different reading abilities. Please have your child read their stories to you at home. The more practice they get the better reader they become.

### Phonics:
