## This Week in First Grade...

**Math:** This week in math we will be reviewing *more vs. less* and *graphs*. After this we will begin our first unit. Students will be using manipulatives to “add” when making numbers 1-9.

**Language:** This week we will be reviewing the letter sounds of *short Aa*, as in “cat”. We also will be reviewing *letters Ss and Mm*. Students will work on the following sight words: **THE, ON, AM, AT, HE, AS**. *Vocabulary: appropriate & inappropriate.*

**Spelling:** This week’s words are: **CAT, MAT, HAM, SAM, HAS, GAS**. Please practice these words with your child! \***Sam** needs a capital because it’s a name!

**Science/Social Studies:** Make sure your child on knows his/her address and phone number! This week we will continue the unit: *Our Earth*. We will be learning about where we live, the names of our state, country, continent, and planet. See if your child can tell you all of the above by

the end of the week! After this we will begin our unit on Apples, yum!
