Also, we have now learned the 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, & 10 multiplication facts.
Counting sequences are a great way to practice these. For example:

2 = 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20

3 = 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 21, 24, 27, 30

4 = 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36, 40

5 = 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50
